Pastor's Message

I. Before Faith in Jesus, God's Son, We Were Captive under the Law (Galatians 3:23)

"28 Now before faith came, we were held captive under the law, imprisoned until the coming faith would be revealed. ²⁴ So then, the law was our guardian until Christ came, in order that we might be justified by faith.

*These followers of God found themselves in light of the Garden of Eden, and in the "days of Noah (Genesis 5:5-10).

*The chosen people were chastened in their captivity in the days of exile. (2 Kings 17:1-18; and of Judah 2 Kings 25).

*The people were caught in sin during the days of Jesus and the Jewish religious leaders (Matthew 19:1-10).

* Now in relation to God and his Law in the Bible: This is the address of God concerning sin and lawlessness today. The Law was established by God from the beginning, for our restraint from evil and clear judgement upon our sin (John 3:19-20).

God gave His chosen people the Ten Commandments as a guardian, until the Messiah (Savior, Lord) would come and free us from bondage to sin, death and the power of the devil (I Corinthians 15:57). This makes the Law a word which condemns us, hounds us in our unabated sinfulness, sticks to our lives and behaviors that will find God's judgement, and will make it clear that there is only one Name under heaven by which we must be saved; that is the name of Jesus of Nazareth, Son of God, Savior and Lord ¹² And there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved." (Acts 4:12).

II. Now That Faith Has Come, we are made new in Christ by grace, and Baptized into Him. (Galatians 3:25-29)

²⁵ But now that faith has come, we are no longer under a guardian, ²⁶ for in Christ Jesus you are all sons of God, through faith. ²⁷ For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ. ²⁸ There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave^[a] nor free, there is no male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus. ²⁹ And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's offspring, heirs according to promise". (Galatians 3:23-29 English Standard Version)

Pastor's Report continued.....

See how Jesus builds His church: There is no slavery to old and sinful structures or attitudes, no bias related to gender or social engineering. We are free in Christ, and free in His Holy Declaration of new life for all who believe in Him (John 3:16-20). Our new life is found in Jesus: "For you are all one in Christ Jesus. And if you are Christ's then you are Abraham's offspring, heirs according to promise." (Gal. 3:29)

The Early Church was born on the Day of Pentecost, and continues by His grace and through faith in Him. We meet in God's Name, plan ways to invite others to come to Christ Jesus, and celebrate loving Christian Worship, Community directed outreaches, Bible Study and fellowship. We hope to share the Good News of Jesus Christ, and will pray with you as the Lord leads and you have needs. We thank God for you as ongoing members of the Body of Christ, and welcome those received into membership on Pentecost Sunday, June 8th, 2025! May God bless


God, Time and History

Constantine's pronouncement of freedom of worship was seen reflected in buildings used for Christian worship. The Emperor himself built a church in Rome (The church of St. John), which symbolized the dawn of a new era. The church was a rectangular hall with a semi-circular niche or "Apse" opening off one of the shorter sides. Inside, it was divided by two, and, sometime four, rows of columns into a wider central space and two or four parallel long narrow spaces. The roof covering the wider central space was higher than the roofs over the side sections. The only daylight came through the doorways or windows pierced in the walls of the central space above the columns. The appearance of this new and fully developed plan for church buildings has led to the suggestion that Constantine imposed it on the church and commanded that it should be followed everywhere. However, it's more likely that the plan was gradually

adopted simply because it was the most suitable available.

The Story Behind the Hymn-"Turn Your Eyes Upon Jesus"

We sing the chorus every week to this meaningful hymn. Have you ever wondered who wrote this and what inspired the writer? This hymn was written by Helen Lemmel. She was born in England in 1863 and came to America as a child with her family. Her father was a Methodist preacher that settled in Wisconsin. Helen studied music extensively. Her parents even sent her to Germany to study with the Masters.

When Helen returned to America she traveled widely giving concerts in auditoriums and churches. She could have been a popular secular singer but had a great desire to serve Christ with her voice. She eventually joined Moody Bible Institute and trained young people.

Her inspiration for "Turn Your Eyes Upon Jesus" came from a gospel tract by Lillas Trotter, a missionary to North Africa. A simple sentence was turned into this famous hymn. She described as being "dictated by the Holy Spirit."

This hymn was published in Britain in 1922 and was published two years later in the United States.

"After her retirement, Helen moved to Seattle where she passed away at the age of ninety-seven in 1961. She had written over five hundred hymns, as well as many children's songs. She also composed and published several volumes of poetry and a popular children's book, Story of the Bible. Her long life was spent looking up, seeing Jesus only, and reflecting His radiance to others.
